Mr Patel has also alleged the complainants ask for free drinks to placate them which

they deny.

On the 30th July I wrote and advised the Patel's on how to minimise noise and went to the bar and gave them free advice for an hour which they understood but have not adhered to infact since the smoking ban there is also noise from patrons outside sometimes over 10 people smoking externally and shouting above the music noise less than 6 metres from residents.

By his own omission Mr Raj Patel is a builder and he has bought this site to redevelop in a few years. In the meantime his son Ash who is very young and is a keen DJ who loves loud music and is obviously a bit deaf and seems to run the premises even though Mr. Raj Patel daughters V and R .Patel are the Premises licence holders who have the abatement notice served on them.

Ash Patel (the bar is called after him) is not controlling the level of noise from the music which is audible till sometimes past 2:30am am next to a large residential block of flats. The threat of seizure does not work and the size of his speakers are massive so I would need to hire a removal firm and a possibly a mini Forklift to do a further seizure!!

My other options are a prosecution which I will pursue through legal however this can take six months therefore I request a formal review of the licence as they have been warned advised on numerous occasions and a serious noise nuisance still exists till 2am and can occur at least 3 nights.
