

1) Safety of Vulnerable Children (Children Looked After)


There were 127 children looked after in Harrow on 31 January 2011.

The bar chart below shows the number of children looked after by quarters from 2006.




There are an additional 22 children receiving respite care / short term breaks (these are not included in the numbers of looked after children in this report).













The bar chart below shows the number of children with Child Protection Plans by quarters since 2006





10) Ethnicity of Children with a Child Protection Plan








