9. Entry to the premises be restricted to persons at least 18 years old (unless complying with the next condition).
10. Before organising any under 18's events, prior written permission be sought from the Council.
11. There be no admission to the premises after Midnight on Sunday to Thursday and 1am on Friday and Saturday nights.
