Introduction

The Council has been successful in securing funding from Transport for London (TfL) to introduce a Traffic Management Scheme in the Kingshill Avenue area.

Following a number of changes on the highway network in the Kenton area, there has been a discernible increase in the volume of traffic in the Kingshill Avenue area. This increase in traffic volumes on these residential roads compromises road safety and therefore residents have asked us to investigate their concerns and suggest means to improve road safety.

This document outlines the council's proposals to mitigate the effects of the increased traffic in the Kingshill Avenue area.

As a resident, the following proposals (if implemented) may affect you and we are therefore seeking your views on the proposals.

Proposals

In order to improve road safety and deter rat running through these residential streets, the Traffic and Road Safety section has developed 2 options for your consideration.

- Option A Section of carriageway narrowing and strategic one-way working on Alicia Avenue. Including the removal of the mini roundabout and the provision of 2 sets of speed cushions on Kingshill Avenue
- Option B As option A plus a section of carriageway narrowing and strategic one-way working on Brampton Grove, making Prestwood Avenue one-way and the provision of sets of speed cushions on Prestwood Avenue and Kingshill Avenue
- Both options will include double yellow line waiting restrictions at all unprotected junctions to prevent obstructive and dangerous parking

The integral parts of these proposals are the sections of one-way working that will prevent and discourage motorists from using the area as a convenient rat run. Each of the sections of one-ways have been designed to incorporate kerb build-outs to discourage illegal manoeuvres and cycle bypass lanes so that cyclists are not restricted by the banned movements.

The full proposals are outlined below and the **2 options** are shown on the enclosed plans.

Road Narrowing's

A road narrowing is an effective measure of reducing traffic speeds. Advantages include reduce crossing widths for pedestrians, restrict flows and speeds and prevent obstructive parking. Disadvantages include increased level of signing and the reduction in parking spaces.

Speed Cushions

These are a traffic calming feature, which are narrow enough to allow a wide wheel based vehicle such as a fire engine or ambulance to pass relatively unhindered. A

smaller wheelbase vehicle, such as a car, however would have to have at least one set

of wheels on some part of the cushion, thereby forcing the driver to reduce their speed.

Benefits:

- Effective in reducing speeds
- Self enforcing
- Overcome objections of the emergency services

Disadvantages:


- May cause vibration or noise
- Potential discomfort to vehicle occupants
- Will not reduce the speed of all vehicles



Typical Speed Cushions

Double Yellow Lines

Double yellow line waiting restrictions are proposed at all junctions for approximately 10 metres of the junction (except where the carriageway narrowing's are proposed). Waiting restrictions are being proposed to prevent obstructive parking and ensure that there is adequate road space for emergency and refuse vehicles.
