

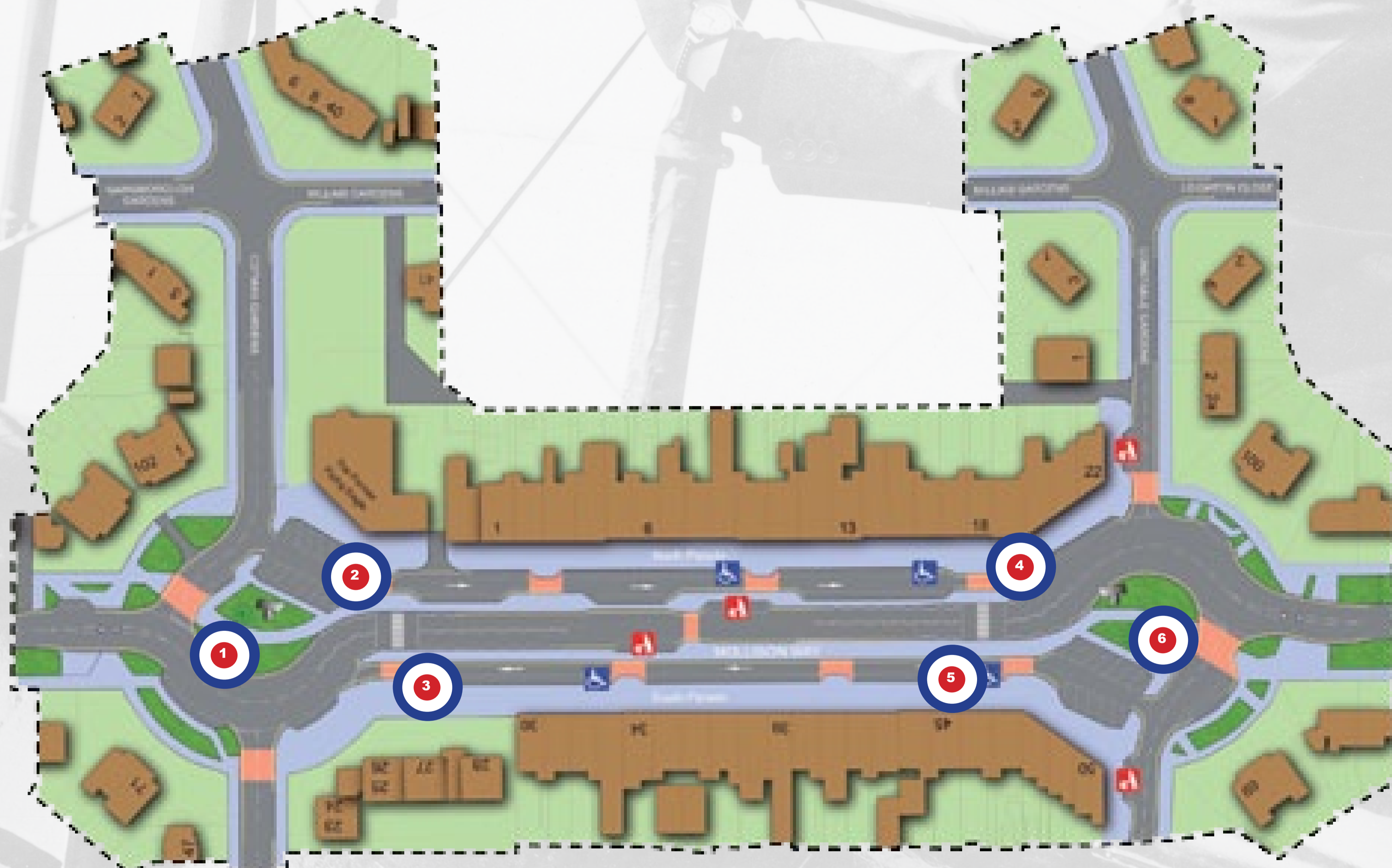
The MOLLISON WAY Heritage Trail
