1. The maximum number of patrons accommodated at any one time should not exceed **100**
2. Window locks to be fitted to all openable windows in the first floor function room.
3. All doors and windows on the premises are to be kept closed except for entry and exit whenever the entertainment licence is in operation.
4. Registered door and/or security staff to be employed at the premises when the entertainment licence is in operation.
5. No noise emanating from the premises is to be audible at a distance of 1 metre to the façade of the nearest residential dwelling.

With reference to three applications being made by:

re the premises: Jameson's Public House , 34 South Parade Mollison Way , Edgware,

to the London Borough of Harrow for the renewal , tranfer and variation of the Public
Entertainment Licence.

The police have no objection to the renewal and to the transfer of this licence.

However , the police position is that we are making formal objection to the application
to vary the licence as it stands. This is in regard to the change of hours sought.

An officer from our crime reduction unit has been requested to visit the premises,
conduct a survey and furnish the applicants with a report on his recommendations.

Over and above those recommendations we also ask that formal conditions be also
attached to the licence. These should include

- 1) CCTV is provided in the premises and is confirmed as being and will continue to be a colour system, in good working order and that a 31day storage system is used and adhered to.
- 2) All entry/exit routes must be monitored by CCTV cameras
- 3) Analogue CCTV system must record in SVHS quality; Digital CCTV must have the facility to download images to a CD.
- 4) The recording equipment must be kept in a secure cabinet or office.


- 5) Door Supervisors are used on the nights that entertainment takes place/the licence is used
- 6) Door Supervisors are registered
- 7) Door Supervisors are in possession of a 'Magic Wand' or similar metal detecting device
- 8) The number of door supervisors will mirror the capacity on a ratio of 1 door supervisor to 50 patrons
- 9) One of the Door Supervisors is female to facilitate searching of female customers
- 10) No entry or re-entry to the premises by patrons every night after 11pm

Police request these security measures in order to safeguard the public, staff and applicant's property.

Should these requirements be met police would have no objections to the increase of the hours to 0100 am on a Friday and Saturday and 1230 am on a Sunday.

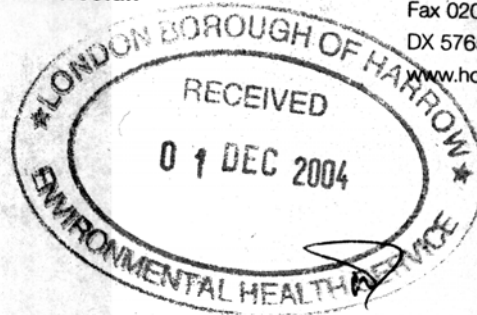


We write in connection with the above matter and would refer to Sergeant Davis letter of the 8th October 2004, copy of which is enclosed for ease of reference.
