

Appendix 5 – Pan London Mobility Scheme proposals

The following wording to be added to the Council's existing Allocations Scheme:

“The Council participates in pan-London mobility (PLM) arrangements and accordingly up to five per cent of the properties that become available to the Council for re-letting or nomination each year will be made available to transferring tenants from other boroughs under those arrangements. The decision as to which of our vacancies will be put forward to the operators of PLM for applicants from other boroughs will be made by the Assistant Housing Provision Manager (Lettings & Nominations)

The ultimate decision as to which PLM registrant will be let the property will be made by Assistant Housing Provision Manager (Lettings & Nominations). The highest priority registrant will be let the property. Where two or more registrants have the same priority, a decision will be made by the Assistant Housing Provision Manager (Lettings & Nominations) in consultation with the Housing Provision Manager or Housing Needs Manager.

As a result of our participation in PLM, existing tenants of this Council can make transfer applications through PLM to be considered for vacancies in other London local authority areas.”
