Summary of correspondence regarding Matters Raised by the Cottesmore Tenants' and Residents' Association prior to coming to the Tenants' and Leaseholders' Consultative Forum meeting held on 6 January 2005:

Officers were asked to investigate data linked to crime and disorder in respect of certain alleyways and footpaths on the Cottesmore Estate, in order to consult on a proposal to consider the viability of enforcing a closure of the alleyway/s and footpaths in question.

Before the Council can stop a public right of way, by means of a highways order, the Council must make a submission to the Secretary of State together with supporting evidence.

Officers in conjunction with the PC Mark Dowse, Crime Prevention Design Advisor supplied details of incident's on the Cottesmore Estate between 23 March 2004 and 24 April 2004. The Estate Liason Officer was of the view that the information provided was insufficient to support a request for closure, which was further backed by Legal.
