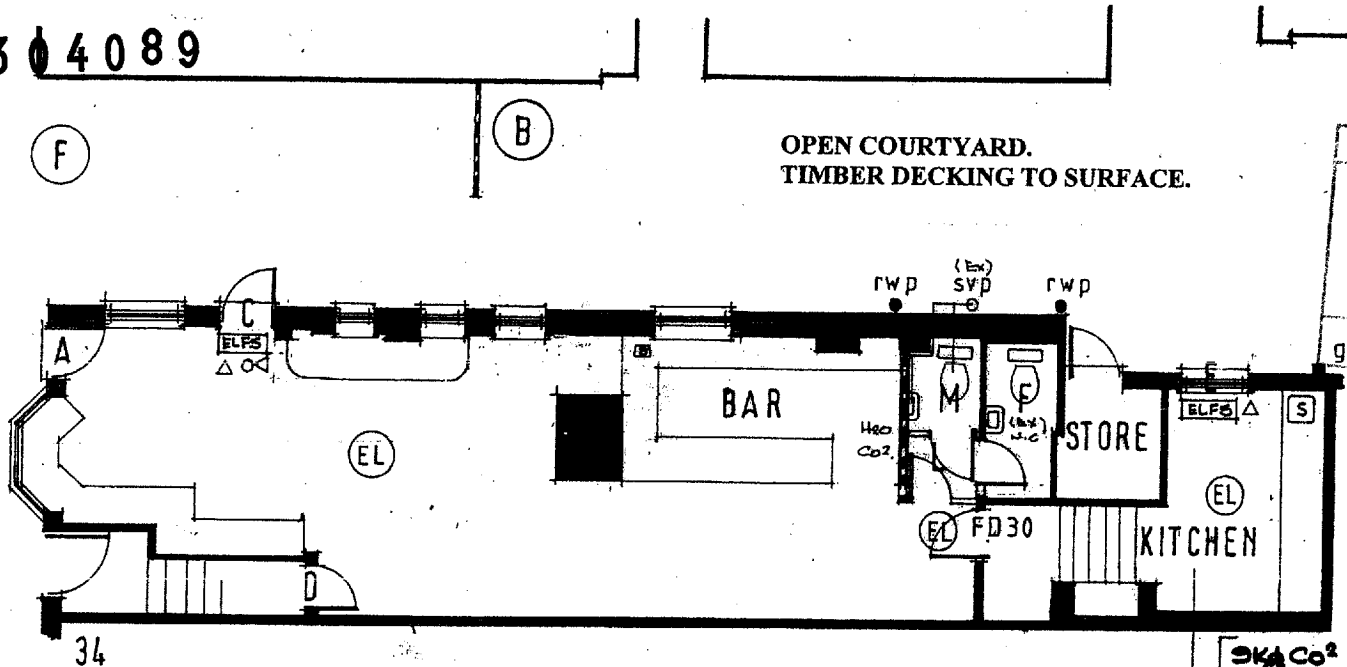

6. CO₂ FIRE EXTINGUISHER.
7. FS FIRE SIGN.
8. FE FIRE EXIT DOOR NON LOCKABLE WITH KEY PANIC BOLT.

LEGEND.

- A. PRINCIPLE ENTRANCE DOOR. DISABLED ACCESS FACILITIES CAN NOT BE PROVIDED AS THE EXISTING OPENING WIDTH CAN NOT BE INCREASED DUE TO THE "LISTED BUILDING" STATUS OF THE PREMISES.
- B. THE EXISTING REFUSE BINS TO BE RELOCATED TO BEHIND THE EXISTING TRELLIS SCREEN WITHIN THE COURTYARD AREA.
- C. EXISTING SIDE ACCESS DOOR TO REMAIN.
- D. DOOR TO UNDER STAIRS CUPBOARD TO BE RELOCATED AS SHOWN. UNDERSIDE OF STAIRS TO BE UNDERDRAWN WITH TWO LAYERS OF PLASTERBOARD TO GIVE MINIMUM 1 HOUR FIRE RESISTANCE.
- E. EXISTING WINDOW TO BE ALTERED TO PROVIDE "SECONDARY" MEANS OF FIRE ESCAPE, FROM THE KITCHEN AREA. THIS IS NOT TO BE CONSIDERED AS THE PRINCIPLE MEANS OF ESCAPE BUT WOULD BE ADVANTAGEOUS IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE WITHIN THE BAR AREA ETC. VISION PANEL MUST BE PROVIDED WITHIN THE FD30 FIRE DOOR SERVING THE KITCHEN AREA.
- F. THE EXISTING DOUBLE DOORS, TO THE STREET END OF THE COURTYARD ARE RETAINED FULLY OPEN DURING ALL TIMES THAT PREMISES SERVED ARE OPEN. HENCE THE COURTYARD IS NOT ENCLOSED AND CAN BE USED AS A MEANS OF ESCAPE.
- L. LOBBY AREA FOR MALE AND FEMALE TOILETS. DISABLED TOILET FACILITIES NOT REQUIRED.
