**a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 9)**

To be added to existing conditions:

1. There is a strong management and security procedures in place which encompass the four licensing objectives as below.
2. Right of admission reserved.
3. Staff are trained as appropriate in respect of relevant licensing law, the implementation of licence conditions, health & safety, first aid, alcohol and drug awareness and conflict management.
4. Customers will not be permitted to take open glass containers outside the premises, as defined in the plan submitted with the operating schedule and approved by the Licensing Authority.
5. The consumption of alcohol will be restricted to those parts of the premises identified on the plan submitted with the operating schedule and approved by the Licensing Authority.
6. A summary of the Premises Licence will be displayed at each public entrance to the premises.

**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

To be added to existing conditions:

7. The pub manager is required to actively participate in and support the local Pubwatch Scheme (where active).
8. Where existing, CCTV systems will continue to operate during the additional hours.
9. In line with our Alcohol and Social Responsibility Policy there will be no promotions that encourage illegal, irresponsible or immoderate consumption.
10. Bag searches are conducted at random.
11. Incidents are logged and recorded in a log book.
12. Known troublemakers are barred.
13. A security manual is available on site.
14. Toilets are checked an average of every 2 hours daily and a log kept of the times/dates they are visited.
15. The Designated Premises Supervisor and their staff will at all times remain aware of their responsibilities for the prevention of crime and disorder on the premises and demonstrate a responsible attitude to the marketing and sale of alcohol.
16. The degree of staff supervision and control as mentioned in (a) above and the provision of a "winding down" period between the end of any regulated entertainment and the premises closing should go to ensuring that 'prevention of crime and disorder' objective is promoted.
17. The Designated Premises Supervisor and staff have been trained and made aware of the written smoke free policy.

**c) Public safety**

To be added to existing conditions:

18. Safety signs and notices are in place.
19. Floor staff conduct physical sweeps inside the premises to remove hazardous objects/waste.
20. The Designated Premises Supervisor and Personal Licence Holders are aware of their responsibilities to themselves, their staff and customers in respect of public safety and will continue to take all reasonable steps to ensure the maintenance of all provided fire and other safety arrangements (including evacuation procedures) and equipment in accordance with the requirements of current legislation as marked on the plan submitted with this application.
21. The Designated Premises Supervisor/Personal Licence Holders have ensured that their staff have been made fully aware of and trained in their responsibilities and the public and to

the emergency fire plan arrangements which have been enhanced to include the provision of regulated entertainment.

#### **d) The prevention of public nuisance**

To be added to existing conditions:

22. The style and nature of the operation will not differ significantly from the existing trading operation during the extended hour(s). Indeed, the grant of the additional hour(s) will of itself promote the licensing objectives as stated in paragraph 3.29 of the Guidance, in allowing customers to emerge from premises at a more gradual rate.

23. Reasonable steps are taken to recognise the rights of local residents and to encourage customers to leave the premises quietly.

24. Managers are required to liaise with local neighbours as part of their duties and resolve any reasonable concerns.

25. Emergency call procedures are in place.

26. Door supervisor and management monitor the behaviour of customers leaving the premises and signs encourage customers to leave the premises quietly.

27. Notices will be displayed around the premises asking patrons to leave the premises quietly.

28. The management and staff are pro-active in informing all customers to leave the premises quietly.

29. Having regard to the variations applied for, the applicant proposes to put the following into practice:

- the duty manager will arrange to monitor noise levels from both inside and outside the premises.

- doors and windows will be kept closed as deemed necessary by the manager.

- notices have been provided outside the premises and will be provided inside by the exit doors and announcements will be made by the manager requesting customers leave the premises and the local area quickly and quietly.

- regulated entertainment will cease 30 minutes before the premises close providing a "wind down" period.

- a telephone number for the premises will be made available for local residents who have any concerns.

#### **e) The protection of children from harm**

**30. We recognise the importance of protecting children from harm and this is supported by: (i) our commitment to health and safety in the operation and maintenance of the premises and (ii) our approach to managing the risk of under-age drinking.**

**31. We will at all times observe the law and ensure that alcohol is not served to people who are under 18 years of age. The manager and staff are briefed on the importance of their responsibilities in ensuring customers are over 18.**

**32. Bar and security staff are trained to prevent the sale of alcohol to under 18's.**


