Answer to Supplemental Q4

Q - Can you let me know, how many appeals were lodged over the same period against parking tickets on the same grounds of incorrect signage or signage being inconsistent with road markings and what is being done to prevent the issue of parking tickets on the grounds of incorrect signage or signage being inconsistent?

A - Appeals are heard by the independent London Parking and Traffic Appeals Service (PATAS). Officers have researched for the information requested, but the Appeals Service do not provide data sufficiently detailed to identify whether signing and lining is the focus for the independent appeal.

A number of measures are in place to deal with issues over signage, including the training and instruction of officers, the taking of photographs of contraventions to provide evidence of conditions at the time and work by contractors to rectify traffic damage and signage changes.
