Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol:

- 1 No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended
- 2. Every supply or sale of alcohol made under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises exhibition of films:

- (1) The admission of persons under the age of 18 years to exhibitions of films must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the British Board of Film Classification, except where condition 2 applies.
- (2) The admission of persons under the age of 18 years to exhibitions of films must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the relevant licensing authority regarding the film in question

Mandatory condition where licence requires door supervision:

Where one or more individuals are required to be at the premises to carry out a security activity, such individual(s) must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.





Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

- 1. The consumption of beverages in external areas of the premises shall cease after 23:30
- 2. The maximum number of patrons accommodated at any one time should not exceed 350
- 3. While amplified music is played, the inner set of doors to both front entrances are to be kept shut after 20:00.
- 4. The applicant will monitor requirements for door supervisors and will take into account any advice given by police
- 5. The premises licence holder and premises supervisor will ensure staff are trained in respect of relevant licensing laws and compliance with conditions attached to the licence.
- 6. The premises licence holder and premises supervisor will ensure that except in the case of accident or emergency a personal licence holder will be available at the premises form 18:00 until the end of licensable activities on Thursday, Fridays, and Saturdays.
- 7. There will be no entertainments of an adult or nude nature at the premises.
- 8. No new patrons or customers to be admitted to the premises after 12 midnight on Thursdays and Sundays and on Fridays and Saturdays after 00:30 hours.
- 9. The premises licence holder or premises supervisor or in their absence a member of senior management who is a personal licence holder shall attend PubWatch meetings as appropriate for the area in which the premises are situate.
- 10. No empty bottles to be disposed of until after 10:00am the following morning.
- 11. A digital CCTV system shall be installed and maintained at the premises to meet the reasonable requirements of police within 28 days of such date when the premises licence is transferred to the premises licence holder.
- 13. A 'Challenge 21' policy will be operated at the premises, whereby any person attempting to purchase alcohol (or other age restricted products) and who appears to be under the age of 21 years, will be asked to provide proof (i.e. passport, driver's licence or some other such accredited form of photo identification) that they over the age of 18 years. Notices will be displayed advising customers that the scheme is in operation. A record of age related refusals of sale will be kept and will be made available to officers of the police or local authority upon request.
- 14. An alarm system shall be installed and maintained at the premises.
- 15. Any amusement with prizes machines in use at the premises will be fitted with a security device acceptable to police and such machines will be emptied at night.
- 16. Appropriate automatic noise control device must be fitted to all amplified sound equipment. The device must be:
- a) Set so that the volume of any amplified sound emanating from the premises does not



cause a public nuisance. A Compliance Certificate must be supplied to the licensing authority for the installation of the unit for approval before any regulated entertainment is carried out.

The installation must be carried out by a competent/qualified person. The compliance certificate must contain the following.

5 minute LAEQ

Frequency analysis between 200Hz down to 30Hz

The Premises Supervisor must ensure that any amplified sound from the premises does not cause a public nuisance by ensuring that amplified sound is inaudible at the boundary of any premises where the occupiers are likely to be affected by noise.

- 17. No customers will be permitted in the rear garden area after 23:00
- 18: Access to the rear garden area from the double doors in the sports bar area will not be permitted after 21:00 hours except in emergencies. Such access will be available from the doors in the toilet lobby area.
