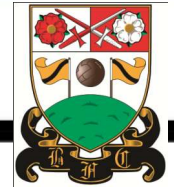


It goes deeper than what happens during the 90 minutes on a match day. We have the power to bring the Community together and change people's lives for the better.

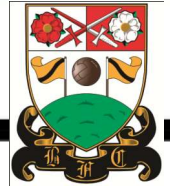

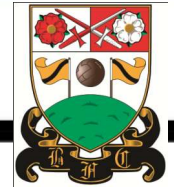

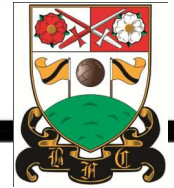

- To create and support community volunteers, both young people and adults.

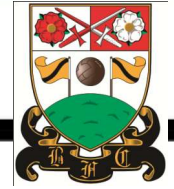

■ Ticket Initiatives

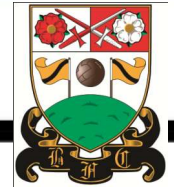

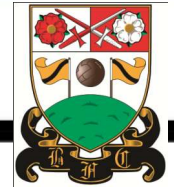
Our courses are open for children aged 3 - 12 years, running from 25th July until 1st September.

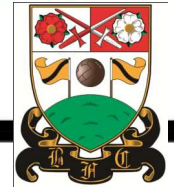
